RE: Seaward Village upgrade works

Defence Housing Australia (DHA) would like to update you on the upgrade works of Seaward Village. As you are aware from our letter dated 4 October 2017, two builders were selected for the 58 upgrades.

In early October, builder one commenced works on Driftwood Place. We are pleased to advise that builder two will commence works over the next week in Horizon Court, Islandview Place and Dune Court.

Road closures will be in place to ensure the safety of all residents and in accordance with the council approved Traffic Management Plan. Fencing will be erected prior to the works commencing around the sites and across the streets between the following houses:

- 7 and 8 in Dune Court
- 24 and 13 in Dune Court
- 1 and 12 Horizon Court
- 1 and 14 Islandview Place.

Please note that access to the beach via the walkway between Dune Court and Islandview Place will remain open.

With upgrade works for Phase 1 underway, an increase in traffic in the area should be expected during work hours. This increase in traffic and noise will be managed through the Traffic and Construction Management Plans approved by the Council. Both builders will ensure the removal of any rubbish and that their sites will be left tidy and safe with the temporary fencing to be removed on completion.
